

**EAST LOTHIAN JUNIOR GOLF LEAGUE
CONSTITUTION**

- 1) The Association shall be called the East Lothian Junior Golf League.
- 2) Membership of the Association shall be open to all Golf Clubs in East Lothian.

OBJECTIVES

- 3) To foster and maintain a high standard of Junior Golf in East Lothian.
- 4) To organise and administer annually: -
 - a) The East Lothian Junior Golf League and Orders of Merit
 - b) The East Lothian Junior Strokeplay
 - c) The East Lothian Junior County Cup
 - d) The East Lothian Junior Golf Championship
 - e) Other competitions and matches when appropriate with emphasis on the youngest Players.
 - f) Any visits made by Teams representing East Lothian Juniors in the UK or abroad.
 - g) Any visits to East Lothian made by invited visiting Teams.

OFFICE BEARERS

- 5) A Committee consisting of one delegate from each member club shall manage the league.
- 6) A Committee shall elect a Secretary and Treasurer.
- 7) The Secretary and Treasurer will retire annually but will be eligible for re-election.
- 8) The Offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be combined in one person.

FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMITTEE

- 9) To define the duties of Secretary and Treasurer.
- 10) To decide all questions in matches and competitions promoted by the League
- 11) To frame the rules and conditions for all competitions promoted by the League.

GENERAL MEETINGS

- 12) A general meeting of the League shall be held annually in such place as the Committee may determine, during the Month of November, to: -
- a) Approve the minutes of the previous year's AGM
 - b) Receive a report from the Secretary.
 - c) Receive a report from the Treasurer and approve the Annual Accounts.
 - d) Appoint someone responsible for certifying the League's accounts.
 - e) Fix the subscription for the ensuing year.
 - f) Consider changes to the Constitution.
 - g) Deal with any other business
- 13) Each member Club will be entitled to one vote.
- 14) At all meetings, in the case of equality of votes, the Chairperson shall have the casting Vote as well as a deliberative vote.
- 15) Simple majority at General Meetings shall resolve decisions put to a vote.
- 16) The quorum at meetings shall be four.

FINANCE AND ACCOUNTS

- 17) The end of the Financial Year shall be November 30th.
- 18) The Treasurer shall be responsible for the preparation of Annual Accounts of the League.
- 19) The Treasurer will apply any "ring-fenced" donations as required, e.g. coaching, trophies, overseas tours etc
- 20) An appropriate person elected by the Committee at the AGM shall certify the Accounts.
