 - (e) EACH JUNIOR GOLF LEAGUE IN SCOTLAND CAN ENTER THE WINNING TEAM FROM THEIR LEAGUE IN 2023.
 - (f) IF THE WINNING CLUBS FROM ANY **LEAGUE** DECLINE TO TAKE PART IN THE SJTC, THEN **THE TEAM WHICH FINISHED RUNNERS-UP IN THAT LEAGUE IN THE CURRENT SEASON** MAY ENTER, AND SO ON, IF THE RUNNERS-UP ALSO DECLINE.
 - (g) IF THE RESULT OF ANY **LEAGUE** IS **NOT KNOWN** AT THE TIME OF THE CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES, SUCH **LEAGUES** MAY EXPRESS IN THEIR NOTE OF INTEREST TO THE SJTC, THAT THEY WILL BE ENTERING THE TEAM WHICH EVENTUALLY WINS THEIR LEAGUE. - (j) ANY JUNIOR LEAGUE, OR MEN'S AREA OR ANY LADIES' COUNTY IN WHICH THERE IS CURRENTLY NO ACTIVE JUNIOR LEAGUE, MAY ENTER A JUNIOR CLUB TEAM WHICH HAS WON ANY INTER-CLUB TEAM EVENT IN THEIR AREA/COUNTY.
- (k) IF NONE OF THE ABOVE APPLY, THEN ANY LEAGUE/AREA/COUNTY MAY ENTER A JUNIOR TEAM FROM ANY ONE OF THEIR MEMBER CLUBS WHICH HAS AN ACTIVE JUNIOR SECTION.
- (I) IF THERE ARE NO CLUBS FITTING THE PRECEDING PARAMETERS IN A **LEAGUE/ AREA/COUNTY,** THEN THEY MAY ENTER A "**DEVELOPMENTAL TEAM**" A TEAM
 COMPRISING JUNIORS FROM A NUMBER OF THEIR CLUBS.
- (m) ALL-GIRL TEAMS CAN ENTER, BUT THEIR PLAYERS MUST ALL BE FROM THE SAME JUNIOR LEAGUE OR BE IN THE SAME GIRLS' COUNTY OR ASSOCIATION. e.g. EAST LOTHIAN GIRLS, WEST OF SCOTLAND GIRLS ETC. WE HOPE THERE WILL BE SEVERAL ENTRIES FROM ALL-GIRLS TEAMS IN THE EVENT AND IF SO, AT LEAST THREE ALL-GIRLS TEAMS WILL BE GUARANTEED PLACES IN THE DRAW.
- (n) IF MORE THAN 20 TEAMS REGISTER THEIR INTEREST, THE ORGANISERS WILL **FAIRLY ALLOCATE** PLACES IN THE EVENT, FIRSTLY TO **ALL LEAGUE WINNERS** AND IF SPACE ALLOWS, **TO OTHER TEAMS** ON A FAIR AND WIDESPREAD GEOGRAPHICAL BASIS.

- 3. FORMAT INDIVIDUAL STABLEFORD. PLAY WILL BE IN THREE-BALLS. MAXIMUM 6 PLAYERS PER TEAM WITH THE 5 BEST NET STABLEFORD POINTS SCORES OUT OF 6 TO COUNT TOWARDS THE TEAM'S TOTAL.

- 6. **QUALIFYING SCORES FOR WHS** ROUNDS IN THIS COMPETITION WILL COUNT AS "ACCEPTABLE SCORES" FOR HANDICAPPING PURPOSES AND WILL BE PROCESSED THROUGH "GOLF GENIUS." PLAYERS' HANDICAPS WILL BE UPDATED AT MIDNIGHT THROUGH SCOTTISH GOLF AND WHS.
- 7. SCORING AND SCORECARDS "GOLF GENIUS" SCORECARDS OR ELDERSLIE'S SCORECARDS MAY BE USED. PLAYERS WILL EXCHANGE CARDS AND MARK ONLY A FELLOW-COMPETITORS GROSS SCORES AND THEIR OWN GROSS SCORES. THE "GOLF GENIUS" APP ON SMARTPHONES SHOULD BE USED, PREFERABLY BY ONE VOLUNTEER PLAYER IN EACH GROUP, WHO MUST RECORD ONLY THE GROSS SCORES OF ALL 3 PLAYERS. A UNIQUE GOLF GENIUS ID CODE WILL BE SHOWN ON THE SCORECARDS FOR EACH GROUP. THERE IS NO NEED TO MARK STABLEFORD POINTS ON CARDS AS THESE WILL BE CALCULATED AT THE TIME OF INPUT OF EACH SCORE INTO THE HANDICAPPING SOFTWARE.
- 8. **LEADERBOARDS FOR SCRATCH AND HANDICAP SCORING** WILL BE ON VIEW THROUGH THE **GOLF GENIUS APP** FOR PLAYERS/PARENTS AND CONVENORS, AND MAY BE DISPLAYED ON NOTICEBOARDS AND ON A TV IN THE CLUBHOUSE. THE **EVENT CODE** FOR THIS EVENT IS **XJHTAM** AND PARENTS/CONVENORS CAN DOWNLOAD THE GG APP ON SMARTPHONES AND CAN VIEW SCORES. THE ACCESS CODE WILL ALSO BE PUBLISHED ON THE DRAW SHEET.
- 9. **HANDICAPS** MAXIMUM HANDICAP INDICES BOYS 28.4 GIRLS 36.4. PLAYERS WITH HIGHER HANDICAPS CAN STILL COMPETE, BUT WILL ONLY RECEIVE THE MAXIMUM HANDICAPS. AFTER "PLAY TO HANDICAP" STROKE ADJUSTMENTS ARE MADE UNDER WHS, PLAYERS COURSE HANDICAPS MAY INCREASE TO MORE THAN THE MAXIMUMS EVEN AFTER THE 95% ALLOWANCE OF PLAYERS' COURSE HANDICAPS FOR STABLEFORD HAS BEEN BEEN APPLIED TO DETERMINE THEIR PLAYING HANDICAP.
- 10. **TEES** THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO OFFER TEAMS THE CHOICE OF TEES TO BE USED ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION, DEPENDING ON THE AGES AND HANDICAPS OF PLAYERS, OR ON THE WEATHER CONDITIONS. AND IF DIFFERENT TEES ARE USED HANDICAP ADJUSTMENTS WILL BE INCORPORATED INTO THE "GOLF GENIUS" SOFTWARE.
- 11. **TEAM ORDER** TEAMS WILL EACH BE FIELDED IN PLAYING HANDICAP ORDER WITH THE **LOWEST HANDICAPPED PLAYERS PLAYING FIRST.**
- 12. **LATENESS ON THE TEE** <u>RULE 5-3a</u> WILL APPLY. BUT, IF ANY PLAYER IS LATE FOR THEIR PUBLISHED TEE TIME, OR IF THE START IS DELAYED, IS NOT PRESENT WHEN THEIR NAME IS BEING CALLED THEN A TEAM MANAGER CAN MOVE ANOTHER TEAM MEMBER INTO THAT TEE-TIME, THEY CAN DO SO. HOWEVER, IF ANY PLAYER IS MORE THAN 5 MINUTES LATE FOR THE LAST TEE-TIME FOR THEIR TEAM, THAT PLAYER WILL BE IN BREACH OF RULE 5-3a AND WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- 13. **NO CADDIES** ARE ALLOWED.

- 14. **PACE OF PLAY** PLAYERS **MUST** KEEP UP WITH THE MATCH AHEAD. THE R&A PACE OF PLAY CONDITIONS (RULE 5.6) WILL APPLY IN THE EVENT OF ANY GROUP BEING "OUT OF POSITION." PLAYERS ARE REQUESTED TO APPLY "READY GOLF" GUIDANCE AT ALL TIMES.
- 15. **SLOW PLAY REFERES** WILL MONITOR SPEED OF PLAY AND ACT ACCORDINGLY BUT THEY WILL HAVE NO AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE PENALTIES FOR SLOW PLAY. **CONVENORS** ARE ASKED TO BE IN POSITION ON THE COURSE TO MONITOR THE SECTION OF TEE TIMES WHICH INCLUDES THEIR OWN TEAM. THEY WILL MOVE ROUND THE COURSE WITH THAT SECTION OF THE DRAW AND ENSURE THAT A PROMPT PACE OF PLAY IS MAINTAINED.
- 16. **PROVISIONAL BALLS** PLEASE ENCOURAGE ALL PLAYERS, WHOSE BALL MIGHT BE LOST OR O.O.B, TO DECLARE AND PLAY A PROVISIONAL BALL.
- 17. **BALL SEARCHES** REFEREES AND CONVENORS PLEASE MONITOR THE TIME TAKEN FOR BALL SEARCHES ONCE A PLAYER HAS STARTED THE SEARCH FOR HIS/HER BALL, AND INFORM THEM WHEN 3 MINUTES HAVE PASSED. PLEASE ENCOURAGE THE PLAYING OF PROVISIONAL BALLS IF THERE IS ANY CHANCE THAT A BALL MAY BE LOST.)
- 18. ON THE COURSE, **CONVENORS**, **SPECTATORS** etc MUST REMAIN AT A **DISCREET DISTANCE FROM ALL PLAYERS**. HOWEVER, THEY CAN ASSIST IN BALL SPOTTING, SEARCHING, RAKING BUNKERS ETC.
- 19. A **PLAYER** MUST NOT **ASK** FOR ADVICE FROM, OR **GIVE** ADVICE TO, A FELLOW COMPETITOR OR A MEMBER OF HIS OR HER TEAM PLAYING ON THE COURSE. (<u>RULE 24.4A</u>. GENERAL PENALTY 2 STROKES!)
- 20. THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR HAS DECIDED THAT THERE WILL BE NO "ADVICE GIVERS" AS DEFINED IN TEAM COMPETITIONS. SO PLAYERS, TEAM COACHES, RESERVES, OR SPECTATORS ETC MAY NOT GIVE ANY "ADVICE" TO TEAM MEMBERS. (RULE 24.4a.) GENERAL PENALTY 2 STROKES!)
- 21. THE **CODES OF CONDUCT** FOR PLAYERS, PARENTS ETC, WHICH APPEAR ON SCOTTISH GOLF'S SAFEGUARDING PAGES WILL APPLY. CONVENORS SHOULD DOWNLOAD THE CODES FOR THE CATEGORIES OF PLAYERS, COACHES AND VOLUNTEERS, AND PARENTS AND CARERS, AND INFORM THE RELEVANT PARTIES WHAT IS EXPECTED OF THEM.
- 22. "RULES ISSUES IN STROKE PLAY" AS A REFEREE WILL NOT ALWAYS BE AVAILABLE, PLAYERS SHOULD LEARN, AND USE, <u>RULE 20.1.c</u> "RULES ISSUES IN STROKE PLAY" AND UTILISE THE "TWO-BALL" PROCEDURE IN CASES WHERE THERE IS DOUBT OVER A RULE OR A PROCEDURE.
- 23. PLAYERS SHOULD BRING ANY **UNRESOLVED RULES ISSUES** TO THE ATTENTION OF AN OFFICIAL, REFEREE OR A JUNIOR CONVENOR. ONLY DESIGNATED REFEREES, IF PRESENT, CAN ISSUE A RULING. IF HELP IS NEEDED PLAYERS OR CONVENORS CAN CONTACT THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR DAVID WARREN, BY RADIO OR BY TELEPHONE, WHO WILL BE THE CHIEF REFEREE. HIS RULINGS WILL BE FINAL.
- 24. **DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES ARE** ALLOWED PROVIDED THEY ARE NOT USED IN BREACH OF RULE 4-3a. (ELEVATION, WEATHER ETC)
- 25. **PARENTS AND SPECTATORS** ARE WELCOME TO SPECTATE, AND USE ALL THE FACILITIES AND CATERING AT ELDERSLIE'S EXCELLENT CLUBHOUSE ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION.

- 26. **DRESS CODE** ON THE COURSE, AND IN THE CLUBHOUSE, PLAYERS MUST WEAR ACCEPTABLE GOLFING ATTIRE. PARENTS AND SUPPORTERS ETC, ARE EXPECTED TO WEAR SMART CASUAL CLOTHING, WHICH INCLUDES JEANS, IN THE CLUBHOUSE.
- 27. **WEATHER DISRUPTION** IN THE EVENT OF A DELAYED START OR SUBSEQUENT WEATHER DELAYS, THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SHORTEN THE EVENT TO AN APPROPRIATE NO. OF HOLES FOR ALL PLAYERS. IF PLAY IS AFFECTED OR THREATENED BY SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS, THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR WILL TAKE ADVICE FROM THE HOST CLUB AS TO SUSPENSION OR ABANDONMENT OF PLAY. ARRANGING AN ALTERNATIVE DATE WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE. DONATIONS FOR PRIZES WILL BE REFUNDED AND THE PRIZES WILL BE USED AT THE SJTC HELD IN THE FOLLOWING YEAR.
- 28. **SUSPENSION OF PLAY** THIS WILL BE TRANSMITTED WITH ONE LONG BLAST ON THE KLAXONS. PLAY CAN ONLY RECOMMENCE WHEN TWO SHORT BLASTS ARE HEARD ON THE
